

Dr. Hall's Hospital Discharge Instructions Following Dialysis Access

Activity

Proceed with your daily activities as tolerated. Walking following the operation is encouraged.

Diet

Continue on a Renal diet as instructed by your Nephrologist. A separate instruction sheet will be provided if necessary.

Wound Care

The wound care is different for every type of skin closure that is performed. Please see below for instructions.

Surgical glue

- You may wash the wound with soap and water immediately. If you have a dialysis catheter please continue to sponge bathe. Do not submerge the wound in a bath for 2 weeks.
- Wash the wound with regular soap and water daily.
- No need to apply any ointments or lotions.
- o The surgical glue will flake off after several weeks. The sutures under the skin will dissolve.

Steri-strips

- o Remove the top dressing in 2 days and then you may wash the wound with soap and water. If you have a dialysis catheter please continue to sponge bathe. Do not submerge the wound in a bath for 2 weeks.
- Wash the wound with regular soap and water daily after the dressing has been removed.
- No need to apply any ointments or lotions.
- The Steri-strips will fall off after several weeks. If they have not fallen off in 2 weeks it is okay to remove them. The sutures under the skin will dissolve.

• Permanent sutures (Sutures that need to be removed) or Staples

- o Remove the top dressing in 2 days and then you may wash the wound with soap and water. If you have a dialysis catheter please continue to sponge bathe. Do not submerge the wound in a bath for 2 weeks.
- o Wash the wound with regular soap and water daily after the dressing has been removed.
- It is okay to apply Vaseline to the wound once daily after showering. No other ointments are recommended.
- o Please follow up in the clinic in 7-10 days for suture removal or 10-14 days for staple removal.

Follow Up and Results

Follow up in our clinic in 2 weeks for a wound evaluation and to evaluate your fistula or graft. If there are any problems or questions after surgery, please call our office at (731) 422-0304.
